

First Aid Kit Checklist

A well maintained first aid kit can prove useful in most first aid emergencies but can also enhance one's quality of life by providing a peace of mind knowing you have the supplies on stand-by.

Where to store your first aid kit:

- Home
- Car
- Community Center, Church, Temple
- On your person

Your first aid kit should include:

- Absorbent compress bandages
- o Adhesive bandages (Band-Aids)
- Medical tape
- o Antibiotic ointment
- o Antiseptic wipes
- o Aspirin
- o Emergency space blanket
- o Instant cold pack
- Nitrile gloves
- o Gauze bandages
- Hemostatic gauze (QuickClot)
- Rolled gauze
- o Triangular bandages
- Tweezers

Maintaining your first aid kit:

- Check the first aid kit regularly and replace used or expired items.
- Store your first aid kit in an accessible, but, cool and dry location.
